Honourable Members of the European Parliament

The Resolution in question is the fruit of deviant communication, of an illegitimate, anachronistic and immoral misinformation that unduly and hypocritically interferes with the process of self-determination of the Cuban people and government.

Cuba is a free, sovereign and peaceful nation in the vanguard of health care, education, sport, scientific research and culture, which has always been committed in a spirit of democracy and international solidarity, particularly towards the poor countries of the so-called Third World, and has always been in the vanguard of the defence of human rights.

Accusations of affiliation with or sponsorship of terrorism, drug trafficking and destabilisation of countries or the entire continent of South America are unacceptable and to be rejected as they serve to fuel the ideological hatred promoted for more than sixty years by US

governments that continue to maintain a genocidal blockade against the Cuban people of an economic, commercial m, financial and monetary nature.
